## Topic this Term

Across Key Stage 4 this term, we will be focusing on 'How we care for others'. We will be looking at the role students have within their communities and how they can be the best citizens they can be.

Maths will see us focusing on time in school, before applying what we learn in the local community. This might look like reading timetables as part of travel training or being aware how long activities take. In English, we are focussing on communicating our wants and caring for the needs of others. In Religion, we will be looking at Hinduism and folding their culture into healthy eating sessions. In PSHE, we will be exploring how we 'Live as part of the Wider World' and will look to explore topics like saving and generating money; British Values; Diversity and jobs people do.

After half term, our topic will change to 'How can I keep safe?'. We will be looking at how to keep ourselves safe online and in person. Numeracy will move onto calculations and data, where we will support students to be more independent in the way they manage households. We will use a range of equipment to help us, including, rulers, tape measures and scales.
